A fun event for individuals, family groups or teams of all ages the walk, now in its seventh year, follows the Chippenham to Lacock cycle route 4 alongside part of the Wilts & Berks Canal. Entrance fee per group is only £4 although sponsorship and/or donations are encouraged. All sponsorship money raised can be split 50/50 with your group and the Canal Trust. Any money raised for the Canal Trust will go into the restoration of the canal along this route. As well as the traditional sponsored walk there is the 'Walk a Boat and Back' event, which encourages any group or organisation that are willing to carry a canoe or lightweight boat along the route. A small commemorative plaque will be awarded to each group that takes part.

10.00a.m. for a 10.30a.m. start at the Buttercross, Market Place, Chippenham.

## New for the 2010 event!

With kind permission of the local landowner we are able to walk a part of the original canal route that is normally out of bounds to the public. This means that, for one day only, the towpath can be walked all the way from Pewsham Locks to the Naish Hill Road near Reybridge.

Entrance fee per group/individual/family is still only £4, made payable to the Wilts & Berks Canal Trust.
